1. USSF E Licensing Course

The E course will be offered in Idaho Falls on March 17-18 and in Pocatello on March 19. This is an 18hr course and you MUST attend all three days to complete your training and receive your coaching license. If you are an approved BYSL coach, they will cover the cost of the course. Once you have completed the on-line registration, submit a copy of your registration to Charlie Brizzee; otherwise, send in registration form with payment directly to IYSA.
