**IYSA.** Dean Cook reported that the State Cup schedule is out. The U12 Regional Qualifiers is being held in Boise June 4 and 5, with some games possible on Friday the 3<sup>rd</sup>. The U S Club Soccer National Cup is being held July 29- August 1 in Boise with approximately 140 teams attending. Dean has been contacted by Nike about having a 3yr contract with them for soccer supplies. It would be 40% off all retail items. BYSL will investigate this option to see if we have enough clubs/teams that want to participate with them.
