Minutes of February 2011 Board Meeting
Thursday February 3, 2011, Idaho Falls Activity Center**

Dean Cook called the Board to order for the monthly meeting.

Reports.

Shootout. Jaimie Prestwich showed the T-shirt design for the upcoming May Shoot Out Tournament. She discussed using a travel group to book team room reservations for the Shoot Out and thus BYSL would receive a monetary “kickback” from the number of rooms rented. She will pursue this option and report back to the board.

Bobbi Tracy requested a raise in Referee fees for the upper age divisions (14 and above) by \$3.00.

Bobbi will schedule the referees for the tournament

Director of Coaching. Charlie Brizzee entertained a motion to approve the current BYSL Spring 2011 coaches. Judy Brower so moved. *Motion seconded. Motion passed.*

Charlie Brizzee continues to hold Goal Keeper training every Wednesday at Sunny Elementary school.

Charlie is proud to announce that he received his NSCAA Goalkeeping Level III license, Reese Jones received his National Coaching License and Jason Muszala received his Coaching C license.

Charlie wanted to remind everyone of the rules concerning “Illegal Recruitment” or poaching of players from other clubs/teams as well as the use of “guest” players. Please check the BYSL website (www.byslsoccer.org) to familiarize yourself with our rules and regulations! Please don’t be guilty of saying “I didn’t know that was a problem.”

READ THE RULES AND OBEY THEM!

Illegal Recruitment or "poaching" is defined as "attempts to induce an obligated player of any team to leave his or her team before the end of the current playing season.

BYSL season begins at the conclusion of the last session of spring tryouts and ends July 31st.

A reminder to everyone of the upcoming USSF E Licensing Course that will be offered in Idaho Falls on March 17-18th and in Pocatello on March 19th. This is an 18 hour course, so you must attend all 3 days to complete your training and receive your coaching license.

U-11/12 Program. Dean Cook reporting for Teresa Keim. All coaches are returning except Dean. Fees and all paper work will remain unchanged. Teresa is working on new form update to include Code of Conduct for parents and players and adding statements about Rules and Regulations to be signed yearly...

YDP. Dean Cook reporting for Maurya Bourgeois. Maurya is the process of signing players up for the spring session. U10 Jamboree will be held Monday, March 21st. U8 Jamboree will be held Tuesday April 5th. There will not be a Jamboree for U8s and 6s, but they will need to be on the field ready to play on Tuesday April 12th for their first practice.

Treasurer. Judy Brower reported that after the completion of spring registration she should be able to pay \$32,000 for SUTL.

She noticed a yearly credit card fee being charged to BYSL that should not occur due to our non-profit status. She will look into this with the bank.

Judy discussed that in her review of the player registration fees, that the BYSL portion was not equally paid by the competitive and the recreational team registration. She felt the BYSL fees should be the same for both the recreational and competitive player since they both use the same fields, refs, etc. It is her opinion that the BYSL board needs to review and change the 2011-2012 player fees to correct this inequity.

Just a reminder for all board members to please go to the bank to fill out signature cards.

Registrar. Dean Cook reporting for Jolene Caspary. Jolene continues to be busy compiling all the registration information for the upcoming spring season.

Fields/Field Development. Dean Cook reporting for Mackay Hanks. The city contract has been signed and sent. BYSL will continue to collect money for the SUTL fees. Michele Sorenson suggested that we need to develop a "master plan" for continued field development and look into hiring a landscape architect..

Fund-Raising Committee. Michele Sorenson is continuing to develop a fund raising plan to get monies to improve BYSL programs.

Website. No report.

Equipment. Eric Langley and Dean will meet and go over all equipment at the storage facility.

Far Post. Bobbi Tracy reported that over 800 copies were distributed. The next issue will be distributed in June,

She is requesting that all spring coaches send her their successful tournament results so she can post them in the next issue.

District II. Dean Cook discussed current information on risk management for unsecured goal posts and potential injury to players.

IYSA. Charlie Brizzee reiterated the state rules for “guest” players for matches, practices or tournaments. The state rule says that if any player who is registered on a team wants to “guest” play on another team, you must contact the current coach of the registered player, contact the parent and/or guardian of the player and obviously contact the player. Any of these individuals may stop the guest player process. The BYSL President and Director of Coaching should be apprised of the request throughout the entire process.

Unfinished Business. None.

New Business. Judy Brower presented an idea to aid the Referees organization in obtaining extra funds to help pay for room rentals, etc. for future Referee Training Courses. She suggested that withholding some money from each referees first paycheck of the season would help with these extra costs. She suggested withholding \$5.00 from 15 and under Refs and \$10.00 from 16 and older Refs first paycheck.

Dean Cook adjourned the meeting at 9pm.
