#### **DISTRICT 91 RULES FOR ATHLETIC ELIGIBILITY RECENTLY CHANGED**

The new policy states that "The high school at which a student participates during the ninth (9th) grade year establishes eligibility. A student who changes from one school to another school thereafter, without a parental move or Idaho High School Activities Association approved hardship waiver, shall be ineligible for one year." An academic waiver is still required to attend a high school not in your boundaries.
