2. U-12 Program Rules and Regulations Revised

The previous rule for unlimited substitutions at the U-12 level was revised to be essentially the same as the junior high substitution rule where the number of substitutions are unlimited at the consent of the Referee at certain times of the game:

1.0 SUBSTITUTIONS

- 1.1 Substitutions shall be unlimited. Substitutions may be made with the consent of the Referee, at the following times:
- (a) Prior to a THROW-IN by the team in possession. ~~If the team in possession decides to substitute, the opposing team may also substitute, provided the players are at midfield and ready for substitution.~~
 - (b) Prior to a GOAL KICK, by either team.
 - (c) After an INJURY, one for one by either team.
 - (d) After a GOAL, by either team.
 - (e) At half time, by either team.
 - (f) Player receiving a CAUTION may be substituted before play is continued (coaches option); opposing team may also substitute one for one at that time.

- 1.2 Substitution is not allowed upon ejection of a player EXCEPT where the ejected player is the goalkeeper.
Where a goalkeeper is ejected, a substitute may enter the field for a field player prior to continuation of the game provided that the substitute enters the game as goalkeeper.
- 1.3 All players must leave and enter the field of play at the half line. All players being substituted must leave the field of play before the substitutes may enter.

3. Spring Tryouts Successful

Many thanks to all the coaches, parents, and players that helped make the two different tryout sessions a success. 4. State Cup Information

Date for U-18 and U-19 State Cup Date has been changed to Boise, the weekend before Memorial Day (May 20-22). Only for these older groups to avoid graduation conflict.

There will be a one-time only U-12 option to participate at State with 11 v 11 teams. This opportunity is related to the fact that Far West Regionals will be held in Boise this year 2011. U-12 coaches will get more information from Dean Cook and Charlie Brizzee.

Second place teams at State will qualify for the National President's Cup. As always, first place teams go on to Far West Regionals.
