



Minutes of the BYSL Board Meeting – May 4, 2005

Ed Wicher called the meeting to order.

Meeting minutes: The April minutes were reviewed. Sharla Cox moved to approve minutes. Motion passed.

Registrar Report (Sharla Cox). YDP is done with registration. Next fall IYSA will require that copies of drivers' licenses be turned in with the volunteer forms (coaches, team managers, & board members). It has been suggested that prior year shootout T-shirts will be sold on Sunday (tournament weekend). We want to encourage more Utah and Montana teams to come to the Shootout. We need to be working on next year's tournament application. The 2006 Shootout will be held May 5, 6 & 7.

Treasurer Report (Toni Doornbos): The IF Shootout did well. BYSL still needs to pay the referees and the field fees.

YDP Program (Amber Lawless): Registration for Fall will be at Taylorview during practice (May 10). They will also be able to register on Saturday, May 21 at the end of season soccer party at Sunnyside School from 10:00 to 12:00.

U12 Program (Don Dahl): Don is drafting up U11/U12 guidelines and would like the board members to review and provide comments. July 15 will be the cutoff for registration for the U11/U12 program.

Junior High Program (Mark Oliver): Junior High Registration/tryouts will begin August 16 at the Junior High Schools. Mark will have the Coaches names and completed forms for the June meeting.

FAR Post Newsletter (Kayla Jensen): The FAR Post will be sent out the week of May 10.

Fields (Mark Oliver): All games scheduled for Eagle Rock have been moved to Taylorview.

Director of Coaching (Bobbi Tracy): Dan and Don received their E course certificates. For all Fall coaches, Bobbi needs the REQUEST TO COACH form. The coaching application, code of ethics and volunteer / employment forms needs to go to the Registrar.
