



Minutes of the BYSL Board Meeting – July 14, 2005

Carol Hoffman called the meeting to order.

Meeting minutes: The June minutes were reviewed. Kayla Jensen moved to approve minutes. Motion passed.

Registrar Report (Sharla Cox). IYSA requires a new form for coaches that must be submitted to IYSA each season. The new form is a combination of the Coach Registration and the Volunteer Disclosure forms. Team managers are requested to discard the old forms since IYSA will not support/use them. BYSL would like to have at least one more team for both boys and girls. Dean will schedule games for the U11/12 and will try to get a couple of weekends scheduled to play Pocatello and/or other cities.

- We are currently licensing over 800 coaches each year. The growth and excitement for coaching education needs to be nurtured by an Instructional Staff that is enthusiastic and energized by helping others with new ideas.
- We have 48+ new National-level licensed coaches in the past year. (National A, B, and C)
- The ODP has grown to over 200 athletes and 10 full teams. In the past ODP cycle 3 individuals have been selected and invited into National Youth Team camps. Additionally, several players have been selected to the Region IV Player pools. State-wide, we hosted over 30 District Training sessions to accommodate practice opportunities for our ODP athletes. We have many players who depend on ODP as a stepping stone to competition beyond their youth team careers....we need to expand the number and expertise level of our coaching staff in order to continue the exciting growth and development of the past 18 months!
