## **BONNEVILLE YOUTH SOCCER LEAGUE**

Bonneville Youth Soccer League – January BYSL Board Meeting – January 11, 2006 at the Idaho Falls Library

Meeting was called to order by Carol Hoffman

### **Board Election**

A Special Election to fill an open Board Position was held. Mackay Hanks was elected to the BYSL Board.

### **New Business**

A discussion occurred on player fees and whether these fees should vary depending on which affiliate, IYSA or US Club, the player/team registers with. IYSA registration is currently required for participation in IYSA events such as State Cup. BYSL's cost to register a player with IYSA is higher than registration with US Club. A motion passed that effective for Spring 2007, player fees will be based on two components; 1-a BYSL base fee that is the same for all players at a particular age group and 2-BYSL's cost to register the player with whichever national affiliate the team selects. YDP and U-11/U-12 player registration fees are as previously established.

Based on this decision, BYSL Spring 2007 fees calculate as follows:

U-15 and above	\$66 (\$50 base + \$16 affiliate)	\$88.75 (\$50 base + \$38.75 affiliate)

A playup request for U-10 player Jose Cortez, sponsored by Coach Amber Lawless for playup to U-11/U-12, was presented, discussed and approved by the Board.

**Treasurer Report – No report.**

**YDP** - Most YDP coaches have been identified. In process of collecting paperwork to support the registration deadline of March 15.

**IF Shoot Out (Todd & Kathy Hampton – not in attendance)** – The dates for the Shootout are May 4-6, 2007. These dates are listed on the IYSA website but BYSL still has not received confirmation of these dates from IYSA.

**Registrar Report (Myrna Garcia)** – Currently has registration for 7 IYSA teams and expects to register 12 IYSA teams for this spring. We will receive US Club registrations from YDP, U-11/U-12 and older teams not registering IYSA.

One BYSL coach application form can be good for multiple years as long as the coach is known and has been an active coach within BYSL. Coach registration forms required for IYSA and US Club will still be required for each season.

An E Coaching Course will be taught March 15-17, 2007 by Steve Adlard, IYSA's new Coaching Director, at Montessori School in Idaho Falls. 5:30-9:30 on Thursday and Friday. Saturday times TBD. Please get the word out.

Steve Adlard, IYSA's new IYSA Coaching Director, would like to meet with coaches in the District. On February 15 at the Church of the Nazarene (1900 Grandview), he will be conducting a training course with Odyssey's U14 Girls team from 6:00 to 7:30 and then will meet with coaches at 7:30. Coaches are also invited to observe the training session if desired.

**U-11/U12 (Denise Hansen)** – Registration deadline remains January 15, 2007. Coaches are being identified/approved. Will determine number of teams once registration is closed. A U-11 girl may desire to play on a U-12 boys team. This will occur in accordance with established policies for playup and director assignment/coach selection for the teams.

**Junior High (Mark Oliver)** – Considering coaches for next year. Previous coaches will have preference. Others will be determined when there is an opening.

**Far Post (Kayla Jensen)**– Need information from Board members soon to support mid January issuance of Far Post.

**Fields / Field Development (Mackay Hanks)** The Field Development group met and discussed its strategy. Issues to consider were discussed. Once initial steps are complete, more information will be available and further actions will be discussed.

**Snake River League and District II (Dean Cook) –**

\*\*\*Snake River League Commitment sheets for all teams are required to be sent to Dean Cook by February 7, 2007. This commitment sheet is now available on the BYSL website. Teams will not be scheduled games unless this form is submitted.\*\*\*

There is a need for an IYSA President Elect, to serve in the capacity during the tenure of the current president then become president for the next term. Candidates from District II are encouraged.

Snake River League will post rules on its website, that will be enforced, concerning cancellations and rescheduling of games. The sponsoring league will be assessed \$100 for any game forfeited and \$25 dollars for any game canceled with 48 hrs. notice by a team. Coaches and teams will need to be aware these rules will be enforced.

**3 v.3 Tournament**

BYSL has been contacted by 3 v. 3 Live and offered an opportunity to host a 3 v. 3 tournament in June. The Board will discuss this issue more at the February board meeting.
