#### Minutes of February BYSL Board Meeting

February 1, 2006 at the Idaho Falls Library

#### **Playup Request**

A playup request for U-10 player ,Nick Williams was presented and discussed. Don Dahl motioned to approve this request and the motion passed.

**Minutes** -The proposed minutes for the January Board meeting were amended to clarify that the special board election held in January was a general meeting separate from the February Board Meeting. January Board Meeting minutes were approved as amended.

#### **IF Shoot Out (Todd & Kathy Hampton)**

The dates for the Shootout are May 4-6, 2007. These dates were approved and sanctioned by IYSA. Shootout committee met immediately prior to the February board meeting. Working on logo designs and all appears to be on track. No significant issues.

#### **Treasurer Report (Debbie Shepherd)**

-The required money from the clubs is coming in. Minimal payout has occurred due to the time of the year.

-The current budget allocation methodology was explained. This methodology needs to be reviewed to ensure that budgets are appropriate to cover expected costs. A committee of BYSL Officers will review the budget allocations more in detail and make recommendations.

#### **YDP (Chuck Lawless)**

-YDP coaches are being identified (see report by Director of Coaching.)

-The registration deadline has been advertised as both March 1 and March 15. March 15 will remain the firm registration deadline.

-The US Club Registration form does not ask for email addresses. This information is needed. BYSL will consider adding a line to the form.

-A recreational soccer clinic will be held in Pocatello on April 16 for U6-U7, April 17 for U8-U9, and April 18 for U10-U14. More information to come.

-Gate City is working to host a recreational tournament on May 31-June 2.

### **Registrar Report (Myrna Garcia)**

-Gate City Youth Soccer has requested to exchange coach contact information between the leagues. Since Snake River League will also provide that information once schedules are established, it was decided to wait for the Snake River League to provide that information to all.

-US Club registrations are currently being input.

-Background checks occur once a year for US Club

-IYSA is slow to get player cards returned for teams preparing for early tournaments.

### **U-11/U12 (Denise Hansen)**

- Registration deadline of January 15, 2007 has past. Coach meetings were held for both boy and girl team coaches and tentative team assignments were made.

-Approximately 60 U-11/U-12 girl registrations were received and 7 teams have been established.

-Approximately 80 boy registrations were received and 7 teams have been established but an 8<sup>th</sup> team may need to be added.

- **Junior High (Mark Oliver)** – Nothing to report.

### **Director of Coaching (Amber Lawless)**

-An E Coaching Course will be taught March 15-17, 2007 by Steve Adlard, IYSA's new Coaching Director, at Montessori School in Idaho Falls. 5:30-9:30 on Thursday and Friday. Saturday times TBD. Please get the word out.

-Steve Adlard, IYSA's new IYSA Coaching Director, would like to meet with coaches in the District. On February 15 at the Church of the Nazarene (1900 Grandview), he will be conducting a training course with Odyssey's U14 Girls team from 6:00 to 7:30 and then will meet with coaches at 7:30. Coaches are also invited to observe the training session if desired.

**Far Post** – The Far Post was issued in January.

- **Fields / Field Development (Mackay Hanks)** Only three weeks remain before current grant application deadline. Need to obtain Letters of Support from organizations and individuals and assignments were made. Statistics on the increase of teams in the area over the years were discussed.

### **Snake River League and District II (Dean Cook)**

-Snake River League Commitment sheets for all teams are required to be sent to Dean Cook by February 7, 2007.

-Based on the number of teams applying for State Cup within the Snake River League and the number of slots allotted to District II, most teams will automatically qualify for State Cup with the exception of a few age groups. State Cup Rosters will be frozen March 25, 2007. Exact location of State Cup games is still being discussed but the tournament may be played at Simplot fields.

- Snake River League will post rules on its website, that will be enforced, concerning forfeiture and cancellations of games. Revised rules as of 2/1/2007 are as follows:

#### 6.3 Forfeiture and Cancellation of Matches

(A) A team forfeiting a match by failing to appear at the time and place of a scheduled match will be assessed a fine in the sum of \$100.00 (one hundred dollars). The fine is due to District II from the member affiliate of the team forfeiting the match within five days of the notice of assessment. The affiliate shall be entitled to seek reimbursement and to impose such other penalties on the offending coach and/or team as it deems appropriate. The fine will be distributed ½ to the affiliate of the non-offending team and ½ to District II.

(B) There is a mandatory fee of \$25.00 (twenty five dollars) to cancel a match. (no exceptions) The coach wishing to cancel a match must contact the District Scheduler a minimum of 48 hours prior to the match. The District Scheduler will be responsible to contact the other team(s), affiliates and officials.

### **BYSL Rules and Regulations**

The Board discussed revisions to the BYSL Rules and Regulations primarily to address administrative issues due to some teams within BYSL registering with US Club soccer rather than all teams registering with IYSA as in the past. One specific issue discussed at length was the existing BYSL playup policy and whether revision is necessary to be more in line with the playup policies of the respective state/national organization. Review and discussion of these revisions will continue during the March meeting.
