## **8. Coaches Training**

- **Youth Modules I and II.** All coaches invited to attend. No fee. Thursday, April 9<sup>th</sup>, 5-10 pm. Midway school in Menan (take Lewisville Highway to north. Pass Lewisville to stop sign/light. Go right about 1-mile sweeping turn to the right. School on right). This course is geared towards teaching learning styles for young players (U6-12).

Coaches fees will be funded completely by BYSL, upon successful completion of the course for all registered BYSL coaches as described in *BYSL Rules and Regulations, Section 5.d.1*.
