New Business

- A. **Rush Teams in Boise** – provides teams to play in March (March 21-23)... you can play Friday, Saturday, Sunday AM. \$340 for 3 games, 10% discount if you pay by January 20. Deadline is March 3rd. If you are interested let Dean know and he will provide you with the contact information for the Rush Director. Last year some of the ODP teams played, they will not play this year. Half the price of a tournament... guaranteed 3 games against some teams they may not see. Dean's team played Montana ODP, Twin Falls, and Rush.
- B. **BONZI**: On-line, waiting to see what IYSA is doing with BONZI. The board earlier asked to wait and see what we got with BONZI before we committed. BONZI gives a scheduler, online registration. BONZI would email changes go to parents and coaches associated with the particular changes. The plan would be that each club registrar would go to BONZI and registrar the teams, and then it would go for approval to the BYSL registrar. There would be on-line payment available, printing of rosters, etc. The charge is \$3.50 per child plus \$99 set-up fee. We are not sure if the \$3.50 is on top of what we already pay IYSA or whether we would not do anything with IYSA. The benefits to on-line registration would be beneficial.
