- \$54,000 is set aside for capital improvements.
- BYSL made final payment of \$10,000 to City of Idaho Falls for the Lights in June, 2014.



Changes of Note

Policy Changes

- Adopted “No dual-registration policy” (Players are not allowed to dual register with both BYSL and another IYSA affiliate at the same time)
- \$10 increase in fees for U8, U10, U12 and Junior High Players
- \$20 increase in fees for U13+ players
- Revised Coaches’ Code of Conduct to Address Risk Management and Concussion Issues

Other Changes

- Adopted a new Logo in January, 2014



- Moved U15/U18 tryouts to June instead of late Oct/early November
- Changed name of Shootout to Dean Cook Memorial Shootout and moved date of 2015 Shootout to mid-June instead of early May.
- Put Sponsor Logos (McCord Orthodontics/Justin Frandsen DDS) on all YDP jerseys to improve quality of jerseys provided to players.
